#### Practitioners' Forum on Suspicious Transaction Reporting and Compliance Culture

Suspicious transaction reporting ("STR") is an obligation of the accounting profession as set out in the relevant local legislations. As the way forward, the profession is expected to establish internal policies, procedures and controls to cover customer due diligence and record keeping. Failing to report knowledge or suspicion of crime proceeds or terrorist property is a criminal offence.

Over 680 members had already attended the last three sessions of this forum. This re-run session will be the last one scheduled for the year to help practitioners understand more about STR to protect themselves from unwittingly committing the related offences. This will also help practitioners keeping away from the possible exploitation by money launderers and terrorist financiers.
